FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What curriculum does Acmar International School offer?

Early years (Age 3-7): International Early Years Curriculum, IEYC. Primary (Age 5-11): International Primary Curriculum, IPC. Secondary (Age 12-16): Cambridge International Examination (CIE)

How will I know if the school environment is right for my child?

Arrange a visit to the school. The best way to get a feel for our environment is by visiting our school, experiencing our wonderful facilities at first-hand, meeting our teachers and observing several of our class.

What is the admission procedures?

Set a date with the school to do a placement test (English and Mathematics). A fee payment of RM500 will be charged in order to take the test.

Are the teachers qualified and trained?

Yes, all the teachers at AIS required having at least a degree in any field (preferable Master and PhD). The school management provides professional development courses (internal and external) for all the teachers from time to time.

How many foreign teachers are employed in AIS?

We have both expatriate and local qualified teachers. We will maintain the ration of 30% of expatriate teachers.

What is the class size?

Maximum of 25 students per class.

Who are our students?

Our students population features a broad range of ethnicities and cultures found in Malaysia society as a whole, however, we welcome students from all nationalities.

When does the academic year begin and end?

The academic year begins in August and ends in July the next year. Each academic term will be 4 months. Term 1: August to November. Term 2: December to March. Term 3: April to July.

What are the starting and dismissal times?

Early years: 8am till 1.30pm
Primary: 8am till 4pm
Secondary: 8am till 4pm

What is the allocation time for CCA?

Monday to Friday: 2.30pm – 4.00pm
